Round 1: Shazam

TIME : 2 hours

DELEGATE CAP: 2-3

Details:

This round is based purely on music. Delegates will have to identify music based on a short sample played through the speakers. They may also be tested in other ways, such as complete the lyric. They could be shown an album cover and asked to name the artist to whom the album belongs or the album name itself. Using these samples they may have to guess the song title, publishing artist, album name etc. Each team will be allotted 5 minutes to try and get as many points as they can, and the points will be tallied, the highest scoring teams will progress to the next round.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Correct guesses/ answers will result in points. Highest scoring teams qualify.

Round 2: Taboo

TIME: 2 hours

DELEGATE CAP: 3

Details:

This idea of this game is to describe something without using certain prohibited words/ phrases. This round is based purely on literature. The term they have to describe can be a book title, characters, locations within the fandom etc. Each team will have 5 minutes. One member from each team will select a chit, on the chit will be the term they are required to guess along with the prohibited phrases. Delegates may not use any physical gestures to describe the term on the chit. A correct guess will earn the team 1 point and an incorrect guess will result in 0 points. Use of a prohibited term or physical gesture will result in negative marking. Each team will have 5 minutes to add to their tally.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Same as last round.

In case of a tie marks from previous round will be compared to determine which team qualifies.

Round 3: Charades

TIME: 2 hours

DELEGATE CAP: None

Details:

2 teams will go head on in a game of charades, 1 person from a team will come forward, he will be given a movie or show from the opposing team (heads will check if the movie or show is viable for fair play), the delegate in turn will have to act out the details of the movie or show so that his own team may guess the show. The team will get 10 points if they guess on the first attempt, 9 points if it takes 2 guesses and so on, making 10 guesses the limit and will have 90 seconds time limit, after which no points will be awarded. Each delegate from the team will have to perform at-least twice and no delegate can perform 2 times in a row. Each team will face all 3 teams turn by turn. This round will be based purely television series and movies.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Correct guess= marks

In case of a tie, overall marks will be used to determine the winner/ runner up.

Note: All rules are subject to change, should the category heads feel the need to do so.
