Composition 101 (ART)

Category Overview

A still life is not simply about drawing what is placed in front of you. It is about how you observe, interpret, and translate a given arrangement onto the page.

In Comp 101, delegates will be presented with a pre arranged still life and challenged to capture it through their own artistic approach. The objects, composition, and setup are already decided. What remains in your hands is the way you bring them to life through proportion, perspective, light, texture, tone, and detail.

Take your time, trust your observation, and turn what you see into something that feels unmistakably yours.

Round 1:

Days 1, 2 & 3 - Delegates are tasked with producing a still life artwork from direct observation, working in an assigned one of 3 rooms, with each room having a different, but equally challenging composition. Delegates will NOT have the choice of choosing their preferred rooms.

Judging Criteria

- (10) Composition - How coherent and compelling is the artwork as an image?
 - (10) Usage of Medium - How technically impressive is the artwork in terms of mark-making?
 - (5) Proportionality - How accurate is the artwork's depiction of form?
 - (5) Detail - How intricate is the artwork, specifically with respect to the actual composition?
 - (5) Personal Style - How effectively does the artwork incorporate unique elements without compromising on the comp itself?
- (35 marks total)

Rules

- Submissions must be an A3 sized piece
- This is an individual category: delegations may register as many people as they like but every participant must work independently
- Delegates using traditional media are allotted 8 hours, delegates using digital media are allocated 5 hours, and must submit complete timelapses along with their submissions.
- Delegates may not alter their room assignment
- Delegates are free to allocate and use their time as they please throughout the scheduled hours for art categories
- Delegates may not use any reference photographs, all work must be done from direct observation
- All delegates are expected to bring their own materials
- The artworks are to be submitted to the category heads when delegates are not working on it
- Depicting profane/sexual/violent/explicit content will earn offenders a disqualification and/or disciplinary action at the sole discretion of the equity board
