Dead Poets Honour (Main Play) (DRAMA)

Category Overview

The purpose of this category is to delve deep into artistic expression and reason with societal norms, to create what is to be said. To bring onto the stage, the feelings, sensations, and emotions that conflict in a person's mind and finally bring. The intensity and hidden monologue, residing in every personality. Teams must unveil, suppressed narratives. And encapsulate the audience, with what resonates within them the most, through impactful dialogue, critical analysis of storytelling, and their energetic presence on stage. To send a message to all. Teams must bring their best and most extravagant performances to succeed in this category.

Round 1:

Delegates are open to, interpret their own stories to bring to the stage, and prepare an original performance. Time limits for the play would be 7-13 mins. In which, they must present themes, plots, languages, characters and their development, and rhythm. This category, does not have a specification, but solid theatre rules and regulations must be followed in order to present the perfect play. Delegates however, must inform category heads about their themes and trigger warnings prior to the category. Delegates will be given 6 mins (no more than that) to set up their sets, and production (sound and light).
