Ingenium (LITERATURE)

Category Overview

The beauty of storytelling lies in one simple fact. Anything that we write about today, someone a millennium ago, in another part of the world, would have experienced it. Meaning the only way we can make our work unique is through the nuances, the structure, the techniques and the “packaging” of it. That is where Ingenium comes in. Delegates would be forced to think in new dimensions, as the main premise of ingenium is to craft a narrative by deciphering Images. The outcome will be completely fresh and unique literary pieces, as these images would be crafted by us.

Round 1: Genesis

Round 1 tests the delegates' creativity and the limits of their imagination, as the delegates would have to decipher a set of 3 images and create a story on that basis.

The delegates would be given the set of those 3 images at the start of the round, which would be given either through prints or displayed to them. The interesting part will be the decision of the genre of the writing and the chronology they choose for the images. This round will mainly focus on delegates letting their imagination run wild, allowing the creation of unique artistic expression. It would be the delegates' choice to either pen it down as poetry, prose or a drama.

Round 2: Unravel

Delegates would be encouraged to bring props to complement their reading and can choose to be very creative in their delivery as well. Multiple delegates can also take part in the reading.
